Dear Parent/Guardian

I hope that all of you are well. I pray that God will keep us safe and healthy.

The grade 12 learners are now writing their Prelim Exams, leaving more space in the school. All Grade 10 and 11 learners may therefore attend school on a daily basis from Friday 3 September (Day 1 on the timetable). This will give Grade 10 and 11 learners the opportunity to have increased contact-time in classes and to catch up on any work that they are behind with.
