ACADEMICS

IMPORTANCE OF ACADEMICS

Academic achievement is important for the successful development of young people in society. Learners who do well in school are better able to make the transition into adulthood and to achieve occupational and economic success.

Ten steps to improve academic results:

- 1. Prepare well for School Based Assessments.
- 2. Attend extra classes from 14:00 15:00 no cost. Make an appointment with your subject teacher. See Intervention Programme for different subjects on different days of the week.
- 3. Prepare each and every day for tests and do homework at the best of your ability. This will reduce anxiety about tests and deadlines.
- 4. Better communication between learner and parent. This will reduce the factor of surprise if the learner is failing. If a learner received results back for tests or SBA's the learner must communicate his/her results to the parent.
- 5. After reports are handed out parents need to attend the parent meeting to discuss any concerns with the teacher of that particular subject. Do not wait for end of year and think there will be a miracle.
- 6. If a learner does not pass for one or more terms, parents are expected to act drastically and can not assume that the learner will be promoted to the next grade, or act surprised at the end of the year that your child is not being promoted to the next grade.
- 7. To prevent suicidal tendencies from your child at the end of a year for not being promoted, attend all parent meetings and encourage your child to attend all extra classes and not to be absent from school.
- 8. Encouragement for each learner: Be organized, learn and apply good study habits, do the work, know your limits, have meaningful and respectful relationships with peers, establish high expectations and clear goals, get competitive, make progress and stay motivated.
- 9. Learners are expected to spend much of their time on their education and need to graduate with good academic results.
- 10. Academically good students have better employment benefits, higher income, higher self-esteem and self-confidence, low levels of anxiety and depression, and are less likely to engage in substance abuse.

FEBRUARY MONTH OF LOVE


It is the month of love and Hoërskool Elspark did not forget about Valentine's Day. This year, there are two events, one for our learners and one for our parents.
