
Please see the programmes for intervention classes grades 8 to 11 and 7th period for grade 12 learners below.

THE LAST PUSH

- 1. Teaching and learning is taking place every day every period in all classrooms. Seventh period for grade 12 learners compulsory and all Saturday classes.
- 2. Emphasis on doing the basics right.
- 3. Do not lose focus.
- 4. Support and monitor your child every day. Encourage them to have a time management plan.
- 5. Dedication from child and parent.
- 6. Exam guideline given to all grade 12 learners for all subjects.
- 7. Focus on SBA tasks done no zero marks. Take advantage of SBA. Make sure learners obtain good marks for SBA. Take advantage of oral marks = 12.5 %.
- 8. Child can not be absent for classes or extra classes arranged. Content gaps are covered.
- 9. Sessions during exam period to prepare learners for next day paper.
- 10. Peer revision sessions at school.
- 11. Just-In-Time exam revision. Allow enough time before test/exam for revision.
